### 8) Maintenance - Supervisors Report

- Courts are due calendar cleaning, however due to hiatus during COVID they are still in good condition and do not require cleaning
- Following a review of our systems it has become apparent that the electric consumer unit requires replacement with associated wiring improvements
- External gas cabinet door has been forcibly removed
- The car park barrier has been reinstated due to non-members using our facility

### 9) Membership and Court fees

• In order to offset the deficit in funds it is proposed by committee that the following increases are imposed on fees:

Adult: £100 Seniors: £85 Off-Peak: £85 Student: £40

#### Juniors to remain at £20 & £5

• It was unanimously agreed at AGM that light fees should increase to £3.50 each for peak courts and £2.75 each for an off-peak court from 1<sup>st</sup> August with an option to further increase £4.00 each for peak courts and £3.00 each for off-peak courts. The trigger being if the deficit is not being materially reduced by increases.

# 10) Yorkshire League - Sponsorship

- It has been proposed and unanimously agreed that the Yorkshire league premier team from Hull & East Riding will move to Ferriby. Their current sponsor has also reluctantly pulled out, however Ferriby has managed to source funding from 9 members to support the team. This will be a great opportunity for members to watch some of the best players in the world.
- Courts are to be donated free of charge (2 courts from 7:40 for 10 matches on alternate Wednesdays)
- Committee to decide whether the remaining court remains bookable by members or will be used for Hull & District or Handicap League.

#### 11) Committee

- Current committee, with the following exceptions, propose to continue unanimously agreed
- Many thanks to Richard Brown and Bob Carroll are stepping down from committee
- Following many years of support and Richard Brown has been granted an honorary membership in thanks.
- Steve Birss stepping down as chairman after serving 2 additional years during COVID and many thanks for all his efforts (including sourcing many £k of grants for the club). He is willing to stay on as committee member to support the incoming chair.
- Martin Shaw was proposed as new chair and approved by those present at the meeting
- Mike Reid has offered to be an advisor to the committee in terms of growing the club

### 12) Any other business

• The new chairman wishes to create some more specific committee positions to try invigorate playing within the club.

Options to increase membership were discussed including:

- An open day has been proposed to introduce people to the club
- A night-class aimed at adults may help, preferably following on from Junior coaching to prevent coaches hanging around.
