2) Minutes of previous meeting:

3) Secretary's Report:

5) Website and Online:

- Courts can now be booked up to 4 weeks in advance (from max 2 wks previously)
- Max courts booked at any one time by an individual has been increased from 20 to 40
- It has been agreed that PayPal will be offered to the members as a means of topping their accounts up and paying annual subs (separate accounts for ease of interrogation by the treasurer)

8) Any other business:
