- 2020 Audited accounts: £9500 (subs), £12700 (lights) + £16000 (grants) income £38000, expenditure £22000 (surplus +£16460)
- 2021 Draft accounts: £17400 (grants), £800 (events), £4800 (lights), £8000 (subs), income £31164, -£730 (subs reimbursements), -£28400 (spent on club improvements)

- Ytd £5117 (lights), £7944 (subs) projected income £12000 (lights), total income £20000, £-8224 (all invoices) approx. £16000 expenditure
- £20115 reserves, £19200 in bank account Total approx. £40000
- Accounting process improved by use of accounting package which allows projections/reports and more accurate real-time accounting.
